General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University Hospital calls applications from qualified persons / individuals for the following posts:

## 1. <u>Medical Officer - Grade I</u>

## **Qualifications:**

I. Medical Officer with valid full Registration of Sri Lanka Medical Council (SLMC) for practicing as a Medical Officer.

#### AND

II. Should have a minimum of six (06) years of experience as a Grade II Medical Officer in institutions coming under the Ministry of Health or Hospitals registered with private Health Services Regulatory Council of Ministry of Health, Sri Lanka under the category of "Private Hospitals, Nursing Homes and Maternity Homes".

#### AND

III. Should have a recognized post graduate qualification mentioned in Appendix II of the Gazette (Extraordinary) No:1883/17 dated 11.10.2014 of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.

#### AND

IV. Certificate of good standing from the Sri Lanka Medical Council (SLMC)

#### Age Limit:

Shall not be less than 25 years and not more than 45 years.

#### Salary Scale:

MO 1-1 - Rs. (58,675 - 3 x 1,375 - 7 x 1,385 - 2 x 1,910 - 10 x 2,270 - 99,015) \* Medical Officer Grade I will be placed on MO 1-1 Step 14 - Rs. 78,585.00 + Other approved allowances.

## 2. <u>Medical Officer - Grade II</u>

## **Qualifications:**

I. Medical Officer with valid full registration of Sri Lanka Medical Council (SLMC) for practicing as a Medical Officer.

#### AND

II. Should have a minimum of two (02) years of experience as a Medical Officer in institutions coming under the Ministry of Health or Hospitals registered with Private Health Services Regulatory Council of Ministry of Health, Sri Lanka under the category of "Private Hospitals, Nursing Homes and Maternity Homes".

AND

III. Certificate of good standing from Sri Lanka Medical Council (SLMC).

## Age Limit:

Shall not be less than 25 years and not more than 45 years.

## Salary Scale:

MO 1-1 - Rs. (58,675 - 3 x 1,375 - 7 x 1,385 - 2 x 1,910 - 10 x 2,270 - 99,015) \* Medical Officer Grade II will be placed on MO 1-1 Step 5 - Rs. 64,185.00 + Other approved allowances.

## 3. <u>Medical Officer – Preliminary Grade</u>

## **Qualifications:**

I. Medical Officers with valid full registration of Sri Lanka Medical Council (SLMC) for practicing as a Medical Officer.

AND

II. Certificate of good standing from Sri Lanka Medical Council (SLMC).

## Age Limit:

Shall not be less than 25 years and not more than 45 years.

## Salary Scale:

MO 1-1 - Rs. (58,675 - 3 x 1,375 - 7 x 1,385 - 2 x 1,910 - 10 x 2,270 - 99,015) \* Medical Officer Preliminary Grade will be placed on MO 1-1 Step 2 - Rs. 60,050.00 + Other approved allowances.

#### 4. <u>Radiographer (Diagnostic)</u>

#### **Qualifications:**

I Passed the GCE (O / L ) Examination in six subjects with four Credit passes including Sinhala / Tamil, Mathematics and Science at one sitting and passed English Language at not more than two sittings.

#### AND

II Passed the G.C.E. (A/L) Examination with a Credit pass for Physics, and two other subjects including Combined Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry or Agriculture at one sitting.

#### AND

III a. Bachelor's Degree in Radiotherapy / Radiology from a University recognized by the University Grants Commission or an institution recognized by the University Grants Commission as a degree awarding institution.

#### OR

b. Should have passed the two-year Diploma Training Course in Radiographer conducted by the Ministry of Health.

## AND

IV a. Should have registered with the Sri Lanka Medical Council to work as a Radiographer in Sri Lanka.

## OR

b. If the applicant possesses a foreign degree, should have registered in Sri Lanka Medical Council for practicing as a Radiographer in Sri Lanka.

## Age Limit:

Must be not less than 22 years and not more than 45 years.

## **Salary Scale:**

MT 6 – (Rs: 32,850 - 10 x 445 – 11 x 660 - 10 x 730 – 10 x 750 – 59,360)

\*Radiographer is placed in 1<sup>st</sup> step of MT-6.

## 5. Audiology Technician

#### **Qualifications:**

I. Should possesses the National Vocational certificate of qualification not less than level 5 (NVQ 5) full-time two year (02) theory and technician diploma training course conducted by Ministry of Health.

AND

II. Should have registered with the Sri Lanka Medical Council to work as a Audiology technician in Sri Lanka.

## Age Limit:

Not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years.

## **Salary Scale:**

MA 2-1 Rs.  $(30,310 - (10 \times 300 - 7 \times 350 - 4 \times 495 - 20 \times 660 - 50,940)$ \*Audiology Technician is placed under 1<sup>st</sup> step of MA 2-1

## 6. <u>Technician (Operation Theatre)</u>

#### **Qualifications:**

I. a. Two years (02) Diploma in Operation Theatre Technician from an Institution recognized by the University Grants Commission.

AND

b. Should have a minimum of one year (01) experience as an Operation Theatre Technician.

#### OR

II. a. Should possess a two years (02) Diploma in Operation Theatre Technician conducted by the Ministry of Health.

AND

b. Should have a minimum of one year experience as an Operation Theatre Technician.

#### OR

III. a. Should possess a two-year full-time certificate course in Operation Theatre Technician conducted by Military Medical Crops, Ministry of Health or College of Anesthesiologists.

AND

b. Should have a minimum of one year experience as an Operation Theatre Technician.

#### OR

IV. A certificate of proficiency not less than NVQ Level 4 in National Vocational Skills issued by a Technical / Vocational Training Institute recognized by the Territory and Vocational Education Commission relevant to the role of the post of a minimum of one year experience as an Operation Theatre Technician

#### Age Limit:

Shall not be less than 18 years and not more than 45 years.

## **Salary Scale:**

PL 3 - Rs. (26,290 - 10 < 270 - 10 < 300 - 10 < 330 - 12 < 350 - 39,490) \* Operation Theatre Technician Grade will be placed on PL 3 Step 1 - Rs. 26,290.00

## 7. Driver

#### **Qualifications:**

I. Shall have passed in six (06) subjects with two (02) credit passes at not more than two sittings at the G.C.E. (O/L) Examination.

## **Vocational Qualifications:**

I. Should possess a driving license issued by the Commissioner General Motor Traffic for heavy vehicles .(A driving license in vehicle class "A" under old procedure or a driving license in vehicle class "D" according to new procedure shall have been obtained).

#### **Experience:**

I. Should possess a minimum of three years' experience in driving after receiving the driving license.

## **Physical Qualifications:**

- I. Should be of sound physical and mental health to perform duties under any circumstance in day time and night time, and if needed should be able to perform in shifts through all 24 hours.
- II. Minimum height should be 5 feet and  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches.

## Visual Acuity:

I. Visual acuity of 6/9 for both eyes is required as per the vision standards recognized for drivers of heavy vehicles by Eye Surgeon Association.

II. When examined for colour blindness, should not be colour blind as per the criteria issued by the Sri Lanka Eye Surgeon Association.

## Age Limit:

Not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years.

## **Salary Scale:**

PL 3 Rs.( $26,290 - 270 \times 10 - 300 \times 10 - 330 \times 10 - 350 \times 12 - 39,490$ ) \*Driver is placed under 1<sup>st</sup> step of PL 3- Rs. 26,290.00

## **General Conditions:**

- 1. Should be a citizen of Sri Lanka.
- 2. Should have adequate physical and mental fitness to discharge the duties of the post well, and to serve in the General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University Hospital or at any other place in the island, as may be determined by the University Administration.
- 3. Should be of excellent moral character.
- 4. The applicants should have completed all requisite qualifications by the closing date of applications.
- 5. The above posts are on permanent basis and the recruits will be on probation for a period of three (03) years, while officers who have served in the public service, are subject to a probationary period of one (01) year.
- 6. Contribution to the Employees Provident Fund (EPF) is 10% and the university will contribute 15% to (EPF) and 3% to the Employees Trust Fund (ETF). (Subject to revisions that may be introduced by Parliament law).
- 7. Duly completed applications with certified copies of relevant certificates shall be submitted under registered post to reach the "Executive Director, University Hospital, General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University, Werahera" on or before 27.12.2023. The post applied for should be indicated on the top left hand corner of the envelope.
- 8. General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University Hospital reserves the right to shortlist prospective applicants.
