

Qualifications:

Passed 6 subjects in G. C. E. Ordinary Level with at least 5 credit passes including Mother Language (Sinhala/Tamil), Mathematics and English Language obtained at one sitting.

And

Passed in G.C. E. Advanced Level with 3 passes (excluding General English and General Knowledge) obtained at one sitting.

Having passed in General English will be considered as an added advantage and Preference will be given to those who possess knowledge on computer applications

Age: Not more than 22 years as at the closing date of the applications

Selection Procedure: The knowledge of shortlisted candidates will be tested by written examination .Candidates those who obtained 50% or over marks for examination will be called for the interviews.

Training and Placement: The appointees will be required to undergo a training period of two years covering all aspects of banking. Six-monthly assessments will be carried out during the training period. Absorption to the permanent cadre will be considered only after producing the certificate on completion of Intermediate in Applied Banking & Finance (IABF) of IBSL.

Those who absorbed in to the permanent cadre will be place in Banking Assistant Gr. III (Salary Grade IX (a) on the initial salary step of the salary scale of Rs. 41,670 – 320 x 20 – 48,070 per month together with Bank approved allowances (10% Allowance, Cost of Living & Rent Allowance).

Probation Period: Confirmation will be subject to probation period of one year, which compute after the training period of two years and evaluation of performance during the probation period.

Remuneration:

Trainees will be paid a fixed monthly allowance (all inclusive) during the two years training period:

- First Year – Rs 33, 500.00
- Second Year – Rs.38, 500.00
